CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

CRIMINAL CHARGE

Count 1: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, DOMESTIC ABUSE ASSESSMENTS

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, April 01, 2017, in the City of Neenah, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, while in a private place, did engage in violent, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud or otherwise disorderly conduct, under circumstances in which such conduct tended to cause a disturbance, contrary to sec. 947.01(1), 939.51(3)(b), 973.055(1) Wis. Stats., a Class B Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or imprisoned not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 973.055(1) Wis. Stats., because this charge is an act of domestic abuse, and further, invoking sec. 973.055(1), Wis. Stats., the court shall impose the domestic abuse assessment of \$100 for this offense because this charge is an enumerated crime under sec. 973.055(1)(a)1, Wis. Stats., and the conduct constituting the violation involved an act by the defendant against her or her spouse, against an adult with whom the defendant resides or formerly resided, or against an adult with whom the defendant has created a child.

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, being first duly sworn on oath and in that capacity has knowledge of the following:

Your affiant is informed from the reports of the Neenah Police Department kept in the normal and ordinary course of business in which your affiant believes to be truthful and reliable and have proven so on numerous occasions in the past that on or about 04-02-17 at 12:30 AM, Officer B. Deich and Jared Reimer were dispatched to 1384 Whispering Pines Lane, Winnebago County, Wisconsin for an after the fact disturbance.

Following is officer Reimer's report: "The reporting person, Tyler Reilly, stated that his ex-girlfriend, [the defendant] Jennifer [J] Dahms [11/16/1984], had caused a disturbance at his residence in which she threw objects at him and hit him with her keys. Tyler also informed Dispatch that Jennifer had left the residence approximately 45 minutes prior in a red Mazda CX7, possibly heading to her address of 614 Isabella Street.

I made contact with Tyler at his residence. Tyler informed me that he and Jennifer have two children in common, a 7 year old daughter named [B] and a 1-1/2 year old daughter named [E]. He stated that his daughters were at the residence with him and had heard what happened, but did not see anything.

Tyler stated that he found out that Jennifer was speaking with another male, and he confronted her about this. He stated that a heated argument took place in which he said Jennifer started screaming swear words and started throwing a fit. Tyler stated that he had video on his cell phone of almost the entire incident.

Before Tyler had started recording the incident, he informed me that he was holding his phone and was holding an E Cigarette machine that belonged to Jennifer. He stated that he had purchased this E Cigarette machine for her, but did give it to her. Tyler said that he told Jennifer he was going to record the way she was acting and this caused her to become even more angry. He said that she then jumped on his back and started reaching for the phone, as well as reaching for the E Cigarette in Tyler's hand. Tyler said that at some point, they had fallen down onto the living room floor and at some point during that altercation Jennifer's E Cigarette was broken. In the video that Tyler showed me, Jennifer was yelling that Tyler had broken the E Cigarette. I asked Tyler if he had purposely broke it and he did not give me a definitive answer. Tyler stated that he could not remember what happened to it, but he knew that it was broken.

Tyler was then able to get up off of the ground and he started recording the incident. While watching the recording, I saw that Jennifer was screaming at the top of her lungs, stating, "Fuck you!" several times. I also watched as Jennifer took a lamp in the living room and threw it onto the ground. She also kicked Tyler in the lower leg several times on the video.

The video showed that Tyler was recording her and getting into her face and yelling things back to her, but at no point did he ever keep Jennifer from leaving. Jennifer had several opportunities to leave and at one point she went out into the garage and got into her vehicle. While in her vehicle Tyler continued to yell, "Good-bye!" Jennifer then decided to get back out of her vehicle and she grabbed a leaf blower from inside the garage. She threw this leaf blower at Tyler's car, causing damage to the leaf blower and the front driver's side of the vehicle. Photographs of both the leaf blower and the vehicle were taken by Officer B. Deich.

After Jennifer did this, she pushed herself back into the residence, even though Tyler had attempted to close the door so that she could not get in. While reaching through the door, she took several swings at Tyler's face.

When she got back inside, Jennifer jumped on Tyler's back and had her arms around his neck. Tyler made several sounds as if he could not breathe and informed me for a very short while he had a tough time breathing. He stated that at no point did he actually think he was in danger of being strangled, and instead of defending himself he was trying to keep his phone pointed toward them so he could record what was happening. When Jennifer got off of him, she then started walking around in the kitchen. While doing this, she opened the refrigerator and started throwing items out onto the ground. Also during this incident, she grabbed a wine bottle and attempted several times to break it while in the sink, unsuccessfully. Jennifer also took the hand held spout from the sink and started spraying water onto the kitchen floor. During the entire incident, Jennifer was screaming obscenities and causing disorder.

Tyler stated that he did not give Jennifer permission to cause him pain, nor did he give her permission to damage his property."

All of the above incidents occurred in Winnebago County, Wisconsin.

WHEREFORE, as said affiant verily believes and prays that the said **JENNIFER J. DAHMS** might be arrested and dealt with according to law.
